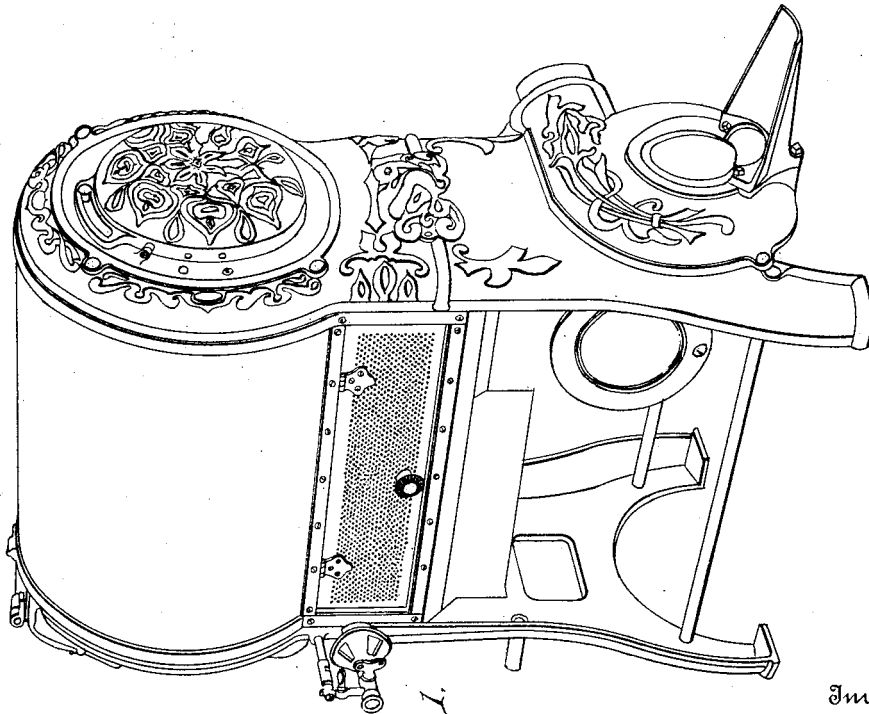
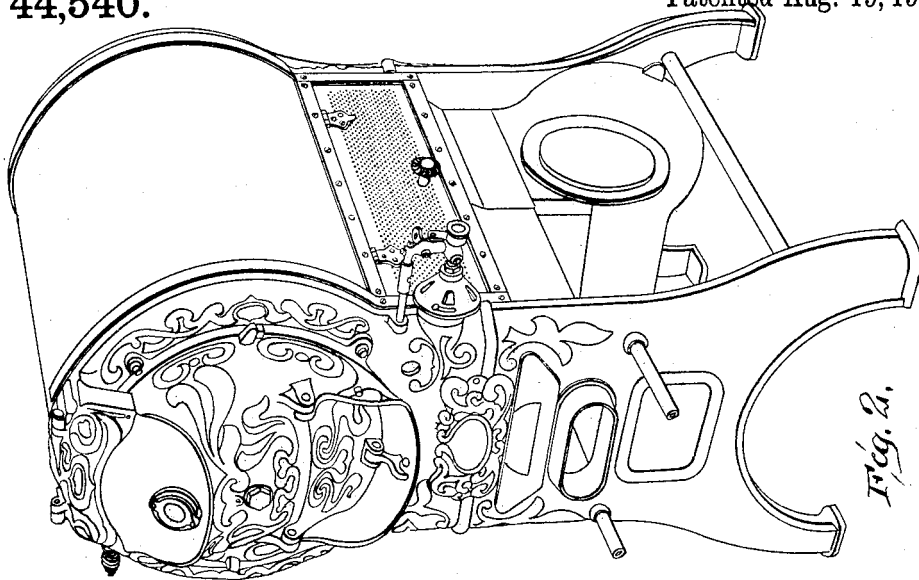

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEF C. PRIMS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Hornell, in the county of Steuben and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Coffee-Roaster Frames, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view looking at

one end of the frame of a roaster, showing my new design; and Fig. 2 is a similar view but showing the opposite end thereof.
